“Linglestown Carol-Sing / Tree-Lighting on Dec. 4”

The annual Linglestown-area Christmas carol-singing and tree-lighting activity will begin again this year on Sunday evening, December 4th, starting at 6:00, in the north-west quarter of the Linglestown Square, in front of the St. Thomas Restaurant.

This year begins a 4-year program of “4 Trees in 4 Years,” in which one live tree will be planted in the four corner intersections of the Square this year and the next three years. During the holiday season of 2014, there will then be four live decorated trees at the center intersections of the Square. The four trees are being donated by the Blue Mountain Tree Farm.

Sacred and secular holiday music for the carol-singing will be provided and led this year by a 6-member instrumental ensemble, led by Mr. James H. Milbrand, who is the former band instructor at CDHS.

This traditional carol-sing and tree-lighting holiday event is sponsored and organized each year by many Linglestown individuals and groups. Following all of the events in the Square, the public is invited to visit the “St. Thomas” social hall at the firehouse, located at the west end of the village at 5901 Linglestown Rd., for hot chocolate and cookies supplied by the Ladies Auxiliary of the Linglestown Fire Company.

At the firehouse gathering, plans call for the re-organization of the Linglestown Area Community Association. Interested persons in attendance there will be invited to sign into charter membership of this newly-formed organization, with meetings to begin in January, 2012.
